

'Prepare for your First Event with Bill Levett'

Each clinic lasts for 1½ hours with a maximum 4 in a group. During the clinic you will learn a number of exercises to help you prepare for the season ahead. Start with what you should do when warming up at an event, followed by jumping a few fences, practising lines and angles to ensure your riding is as accurate as possible for cross country and show jumping. At the end of the session you will string a number of fences together to practise your course riding skills, to ensure you have the best possible chance of getting a clear round.

Bill Levett has ridden at four star level, Burghley and Badminton, and achieved placing's in the top ten. He is currently on the Australian Elite Squad preparing for his 2012 Olympic Bid. Bills way of teaching is sympathetic to the rider, by making the point he is getting across as simple as possible means that any rider can understand what he is teaching. Terms and Conditions

1. Horse/Pony sports are dangerous. Neither the Professional Equine Training committee, nor any persons acting on their behalf, nor the landowner can accept any liability for loss, damage, accident or injury to any persons, horses or property.
2. It is compulsory that all riders wear hats/helmets up to British Standard Riding Hats conforming to BS PAS 015 1998, BS EN 1384, or ASTM 1163 95.
3. Riding is a risk sport and it is compulsory that all riders wear body protectors to the latest BETA standard.
4. It is compulsory that every person entering upon the Professional Equine Training venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
5. It is compulsory that all dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
6. It is compulsory that horseboxes are not to be mucked out on site.
7. It is compulsory that all gates must be kept closed.
8. The Management of the venue or Professional Equine Training reserves the right to remove anyone from the course at any time without giving a reason.
9. You note and accept there will be a no medical or veterinary cover on site.
10. All schooling may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check on 07962 251 696 before departing.
11. All horses/ponies must be over four years old.
12. In the event of a cancellation, entry fees will be returned on receipt of a S.A.E. A £10 admin fee is retained.
13. Withdrawals/cancellations will only have their entry fees returned on receipt of a vet or doctor's certificate and a S.A.E within 7 days of the time of withdrawal. A £10 admin fee is retained.

The course's owner/instructor or Professional Equine Training does not insure the rider, your horse or your tack and equipment. You are strongly advised to have in place your own adequate personal accident insurance at all times.
